## GALLERY SPACE

The ground floor at Georges House has been developed by Strange Cargo Arts Company as a contemporary gallery venue, offering a dedicated, flexible exhibition space on wall (19 linear metres), floor (52 square metres), and window plinth. The corner site at the gateway to Folkestone's Creative Quarter offers extensive views into the gallery from both the Old High Street and Bayle Street, and is situated on a busy thoroughfare linking the seafront and the Town Centre.

An application for use of the gallery in the form of a detailed proposal will be considered subject to its availability as part of the annual programme, and whether an opening in the schedule is available.

Successful applicants are required to meet the following terms and conditions of use of the Gallery.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

FEES	£60.00 +VAT @ 17/5% per week payable one month advance on receipt an invoice. Minimum booking period two weeks.
CANCELLATION	In the event of cancellation, one months notice must be given in writing, otherwise the full cost of hire will still apply.
COMMISSION	20% + VAT @ 17.5% on sales made during the course of the exhibition. The artist will be responsible for recording all sales and a commission invoice will be issued at the end of the exhibition period.

- Exhibition are responsible for insurance of exhibits
- Strange Cargo accept no liability for damage, loss, costs or expenses incurred by the applicant whiles using the Gallery, and the applicant must be adequately insure in respect f Third Party and Public Liability risks.
- Applicants will be responsible for invigilating the exhibition and the security of the Gallery during their period of occupation. In the event that he hirer is unable to invigilate Strange Cargo can arrange stewarding at an extra cost of £35.00 per day plus VAT.
- There shall be no musical, theatre, cinematographic performances unless:
  - a) A licence for the same shall have first been obtained from the appropriate authority.
  - b) All necessary measures shall have been take to fulfil the conditions of grant of licence of such authority.
  - c) Any and all such conditions relating to performance rights shall be observed

No appeal for funds for any charity may be made and material of political or sectarian religious nature is excluded. Strange Cargo reserve the right to refuse any application for use of the Gallery and in doing so, need not state the reason for which the application is refused.
